Cyber Hacks: Credential Harvesting is Year-Round

Credential Harvesting is the gathering of compromised user credentials such as usernames and passwords. Credential harvesting uses social engineering techniques to obtain legitimate user IDs (and passwords) allowing access to a network. Techniques include an attacker sending an email with a link to a spoofed website that looks legitimate, or a person posing as an authoritative resource to fraudulently obtain a user's log-on ID or password.



The credentials will be used for subsequent attacks where the goal is to gain access to systems or network resources, or they can be monetized by taking over bank accounts or simply selling the information on the Dark Web.

Cybersecurity Best Practices:

- **Sharing your credentials (username and password):** Avoid sharing your credential in unfamiliar websites that are shared by email
- **Security Awareness:** Complete cyber security awareness annual training in the iLMS platform
- **Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA):** Brinks utilize OKTA for MFA and it provides an additional layer of security to our digital privacy
- **Report Phishing:** Report suspicious email using the Report Phishing Cofense button in Microsoft Outlook toolbar
- **Actively monitor failed authentications:** When monitoring login activity in your accounts, look for any type of discernable patterns in these failed authentications and track them over time
