

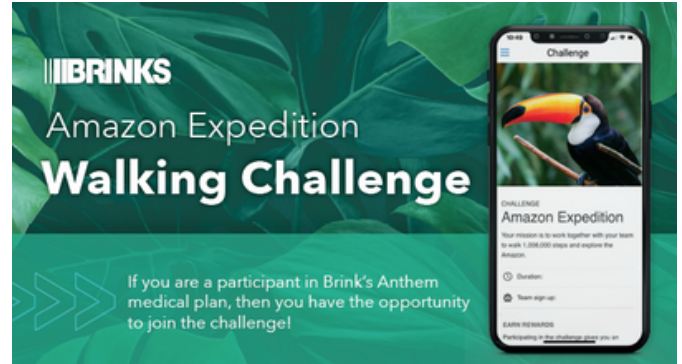

Cyber Hacks: Beware of Spear Phishing



Spear phishing is an email targeted at a specific individual or department within an organization that appears to be from a trusted source. It's a method used by cybercriminals to attempt to steal confidential information. Attackers disguise themselves as someone their victim trusts, usually a friend or colleague, and attempts to acquire sensitive information via email or instant messaging tools.

How to Better Protect Yourself Against Spear Phishing?

- Security awareness training plays a critical role in defending against spear phishing by learning how to identify and how to report a potential spear phishing email.
- Any message asking for sensitive financial or request for a transaction should be verified even if the sender looks like a legitimate employee or vendor.
- Be suspicious of any email message with an urgent tone or for immediate attention.
- Avoid oversharing work and personal information in social media .
- Use multi-factor authentication when available.
- Report suspicious email using the Cofense Report button located in your Outlook toolbar.

Madeline Albright (1937 - 2022)

Madeleine Albright- was a refugee brought to the U.S. as a child after fleeing Nazis and communists and who went on to become the first woman to serve as secretary of state. Her previous tenure as ambassador to the U.N shifted the way women diplomats were viewed at the U.N. She was also known for using her jewelry as a diplomatic tool to show her opinion of the situation.

Georgia O'Keeffe (1887 - 1986)

Georgia O'Keeffe is known as the "Mother of American Modernism". O'Keeffe became one of the first female painters to gain respect in the New York art scene in the 1920s. She is most famous for her works of New Mexico landscapes and her abstract paintings of flowers that have been widely interpreted by critics to represent female sensuality.

Mellody Hobson

Mellody Hobson is an American businesswoman who is President and co-CEO of Ariel Investments, and the first black female chairwoman of Starbucks Corporation.
