Here are a few pointers:

- Create Specific, Measurable, Aligned, Realistic and Time bound (SMART) goals aligned with your manager and matrix manager (if applicable).
- Set challenging goals that align with company objectives and the business strategy.
- Limit goals to the vital few (three to five) that will help drive the achievement of our business objectives
- If you have a matrix manager, the matrix manager should provide input and sign off on your goals as well.

HOW TO VIEW YOUR W-2 IN WORKDAY:

- Log into Workday
- Select the Pay icon
- Select My Tax Documents
- For tax year 2021, select View/Print under Employee Copy
- A pop-up window will appear. Select Notify Me Later. After a few moments, your document will be available.

Cyber Hacks - Internet Browsing Best Practices

We all know how easy it is to get distracted while surfing the Internet. A seemingly harmless link may be a trap to trick you in to sharing information you never intended to share. Therefore, it is very important that you are watchful and develop browsing habits that will help you improve the security of your online activities.

Follow these internet safety tips for avoiding spyware and strengthen your computer security right away:

Connect to websites through HTTPS

• You should always check the URL of a website to make sure that it has the "HTTPS://" or a padlock icon. This is your confirmation that a layer of encryption protects the website you are using.

Don't reuse passwords

• Using the same password for multiple sites only makes it easier for attackers to compromise your sensitive information.

Block pop-ups and scripts

• Pop-ups are often forms of online advertising intended to attract web traffic or capture email addresses. Pop-ups open new web browser windows to display advertisements.

Avoid public or free Wi-Fi

• Attackers often use wireless sniffers to steal users' information as it is sent over unprotected networks. The best way to protect yourself from this is to avoid using these networks altogether.

Keep your personal computer browser software up-to-date

• It is essential to be using the latest version of the web browser of your choice. In particular, Chrome and Firefox have a security feature known as the Auto Update.

Elana Meyers Taylor

In 2015, Elana made history, becoming the first woman to earn a spot on the U.S. National Team competing with the men as a four-man bobsled pilot. She won the 2015 World Championships in the women's two-man event, the first woman in U.S. history to do so. Elana won two silver medals for bobsledding at the 2018 Winter Olympics, winning her second while injured.

Sidney Poitier 1927-2022

A Bahamian-American actor and diplomat. He was described as the "sole representative" of African-Americans in mainstream cinema during the 1950s and 1960s, especially during the height of the American Civil Rights movement. In 1963, he became the first Black actor to win an Academy Award for Best Actor. Poitier also received the Kennedy Center Honor and in 2009, Poitier was awarded the Presidential Medal of Freedom from Barack Obama.

Daniel Hale Williams 1856-1931

Daniel Hale Williams was one of the first physicians to perform open-heart surgery in the United States. In May 1891, Williams opened Provident Hospital and Training School for Nurses, the nation's first hospital with a nursing and intern program that had a racially integrated staff.
