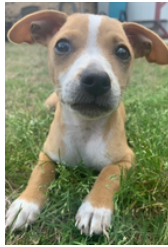

Cyber Hacks: Phishing vs. Spam - Both Losers!

Spam is called junk mail for reason. It is a means of selling products or services to a larger market of buyers and the name comes from a TV show sketch where the canned meat product Spam is ubiquitous, unavoidable, and repetitive. After obtaining the email addresses of a huge number of individuals, spammers bulk send their offers to hundreds or thousands at a time.



Whereas spam is simply unwanted, **phishing** is specifically designed by a cyber attacker to harm a company or individual by obtaining sensitive information. It often takes the form of a seemingly legitimate-looking message from a trusted sender. Phishing emails will target banking credentials, passwords, cash advances, or other information of value. Identity theft is often a result. Emails will often contain URLs, or links, to malicious web pages asking for your private information.

Tips on how to protect yourself against phishing and spam email:

- Attackers often use weird email addresses that appear to come from a trustworthy source to trick the recipient. Always look carefully at the email sender, the content tone and urgency of the message.
- Never open links or attached files, including opt-out or unsubscribe links, from unknown or suspicious emails. Spammers and phishers sometimes include these links to confirm that your email address is legitimate or the links may trigger malicious webpages or downloads.
- Always report suspicious email using the Cofense Report Phishing button in the Outlook toolbar.
