Cyber Hacks: Best Practices to Secure IoT Devices

The **Internet of Things (IoT)** describes the network of physical objects—"things"—that are embedded with sensors, software, and other technologies for the purpose of connecting and exchanging data with other devices and systems over the internet.


Internet of Things (IoT) security is becoming increasingly important when it comes to the big picture of cybersecurity. While cybersecurity seeks to protect internet-connected systems from cyber threats, IoT security is about protecting the data transferring through connected devices.

Tips on how to improve the security of IoT devices:

- Never assume an IoT device is incapable of being hacked
- Use a different password for each device/service and never stick with the default password
- Keep your connected devices up to date with the latest firmware and software
- Turn off Wi-Fi or Bluetooth when the connectivity features are not needed
- Put IoT devices on their own network separate from your most important systems
