

Thinking Resilience: Preparing for Winter Storms

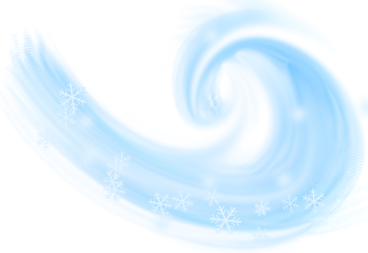


Winter storms have already impacted some parts of the country, but **here are three suggested steps to consider in preparedness for severe winter weather:**

Get Informed - Winter storms can bring extreme cold, freezing rain, snow, ice and high winds. With a little planning, you can protect yourself and others. A useful tip is keeping up to date on the latest weather reports.

Be Prepared - The main concerns related to winter weather are loss of heat, power and telephone service, as well as a shortage of supplies if storm conditions are severe. Take an inventory of emergency items on hand to make sure you have everything needed to survive for three to five days.

Respond - When caught in a winter storm, it's essential to find shelter, stay dry and cover all exposed body parts. Use fire safeguards and properly ventilate when using heat from open sources.

Cyber Hacks: Security Tips for Holiday Shopping



Five security tips for online shopping this holiday season:

1. Never install unfamiliar software

There are hundreds of shopping apps out there and some of them may be malicious, so only use apps that you know and trust.

2. Verify attachments are safe before downloading them

A common tactic among cybercriminals is to create phony email notifications from a retailer or postal service. These notifications often include a malicious attachment.

3. Verify links before clicking

When online shopping, only click on an ad or link from a reputable source, such as a retailer's official social media profile.

4. Secure your devices

Never leave your phone, tablet, or computer unattended. Try to take your device with you wherever you go. If you do need to step away, lock your device.

5. Use strong password phrases

Use a strong password phrase for all your devices, apps and services!
