## 2022 IRS Form 1095-C: Available in Workday Now

IRS Form 1095-C is available in Workday now. Forms are being printed and mailed on January 31 to the address on record in Workday. If you have questions about your form, please email the **Benefits Service Center** at [benefitservices@brinksinc.com](mailto:benefitservices@brinksinc.com).

Form 1095-C will indicate your name and the name of your large employer, the months during the prior calendar year when you were eligible for coverage, and the cost of the cheapest monthly premium you could have paid for coverage under your employer's health plan.

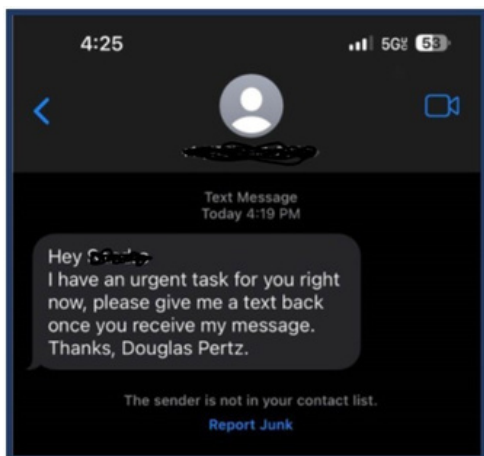


### HOW TO VIEW YOUR 1095-C IN WORKDAY

From your **Home Dashboard** in Workday

1. In the *Search Bar* type *My ACA Forms*
2. Click the **"Report"** button
3. Update your 1095-C Printing Elections: Click the **Change 1095-C Printing Election** button
4. Select the **"View/Print"** button for the appropriate tax year.
5. Follow the on screen prompts for delivery.

## Cyber Hacks: Be Alert! Recent Smishing Campaign



The **Global Information Security Team (GIS)** has detected a recent text message scam (smishing) campaign attempting to impersonate Brink's employees.

### Steps to take:

- Remember to never respond to smishing messages or ask the sender to stop contacting you.
- Delete the message from your phone.
- Take your time. Text message scams work by creating a false sense of urgency by demanding an immediate response.
- Never click on any links or call any phone numbers in an unsolicited text or email message.
- Report the message to your cell phone service carrier's spam text reporting number or customer service number.



Your awareness of cybersecurity practices and diligence in detecting and reporting malicious activity is our first line of defense. **Please continue to follow best practices and do not respond to these messages if received.**
