

Cyber Hacks: Bluetooth on Devices

It's important to be aware of these risks and take necessary precautions. **One of the main concerns is privacy.** Bluetooth devices constantly transmit and receive signals, which can be intercepted by attackers.

This introduces a risk of unauthorized access to your device and could **potentially expose sensitive information**, such as your location or personal data. If an attacker gains access to your Bluetooth device, they may be able to control or manipulate it, potentially leading to various security breaches or malicious activities.



To stay safe while using Bluetooth devices, like Apple AirTag, here are a few important tips:

- 1. Keep your Bluetooth device updated
- 2. Enable device visibility judiciously
- 3. Use strong and unique passwords
- 4. Be cautious with public or untrusted networks
- 5. Regularly review connected devices
