Cyber Hacks: Internet of Things (IoT) Security is Critical



Every day items such as smartphones, smart TVs, smart speakers, connected thermostats, home security systems, robot vacuums, smart bulbs, energy monitors, connected appliances, and smart door locks are all considered Internet of Things (IoT) devices. In fact, any device that connects to the internet to transmit data, is likely an IoT device. Security for these resources is critical important because the **devices might be exploited to obtain unauthorized access to your systems, leaving you vulnerable to attacks.**

IoT Security Best Practices:

- Use strong passphrases for all connected devices and always create complex passwords.
- If possible, enable multi-factor authentication.
- Take inventory of your linked devices on a regular basis and disable any items that are not in use.
- Monitor all network devices and act quickly if any device shows indicators of compromise.
- Use the greatest level of encryption available, which is currently WPA2/WP3.
- If you are selling or discarding a device, make sure to factory reset and erase all settings.

Thinking Resilience: Hurricane Season is Here



Hurricane season is here (**June 1 - November 30**) and with September being the busiest, the time to prepare is never better than now. Recent years have seen increased hurricane activity, and many situations with rapid intensification occur before landfall, leaving little time for last-minute preparations. **By planning, you can ensure your team members stay safe and weather the storm.**

Four steps you can take to help ensure your team's safety:

1. **Plan** - Work with your team to follow the steps in the branch preparation checklist that we have in the playbook.
2. **Make a kit** - Have in place all branch emergency supplies and keep them readily available. Refer to the branch supplies and resources in the Business Resilience Playbook for recommendations on personal protective equipment and safe work practices. If you don't have the Playbook at hand, please reach out to the Global Business Resilience Team for a copy.
3. **Know the hazards** - Work conditions can change dramatically following a storm. Be aware of potential hazards and talk to your team now about the best equipment and practices. Ensure to always be in communication with the Incident Response Team.
4. **Stay aware** - Follow your regional weather forecasts and remember storms can change direction or increase intensity with little warning. If a storm hits, continue to track reports to stay aware of storm-related hazards. Bookmark the websites of your local National Weather Service.

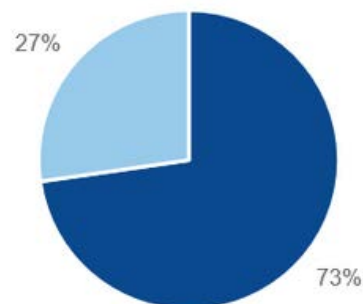
