Recently, Brink's announced results for the second quarter and held the earnings webcast. Overall, the results indicated:

- Record Second Quarter Revenue and Operating Profit
- Strong Year-to-Date Cash Generation with an Increase of Over 150% in Net Cash from Operations
- Affirmed Full-Year 2023 Guidance

More Results Highlights:

- Q2 Revenue up 7%, reflecting 8% organic growth
- Q2 Operating profit: GAAP up 9% to \$106M; non-GAAP up 6% to \$132M
- Q2 Operating margin: GAAP up 2% to 8.7%; non-GAAP down 1% to 10.8%
- Q2 GAAP net income down 9% to \$32M; adjusted EBITDA up 4% to \$194M
- Q2 EPS: GAAP \$0.68; non-GAAP \$1.18
- YTD GAAP net cash from operations up \$64M to \$105M; non-GAAP free cash flow up \$115M to \$66M

Cyber Hacks: Some Cookies are Tricks Not Treats!

According to the Federal Trade Commission, **a cookie is information saved by your web browser.** When you visit a website, the site may place a cookie on your web browser so it can recognize your device in the future. If you return to that site later, it can read that cookie to remember you from your last visit, keeping track of your activities over time.



While most cookies are perfectly safe, **some can be used to track you without your consent.** Legitimate cookies can sometimes be spied upon if a criminal gets access.

Tips for a More Secure Browsing Experience:

- **Clean out the cookie jar:** Make it a habit to clear your cookie cache regularly to prevent cookie overload, which could slow your search speeds.
- **Turn off autofill features:** Although it's convenient to not have to re-type your credentials into a website you frequently visit, autofill features could make it easier for a criminal to extract your data with cookie hijacking.
- **Always use multi-factor authentication:** Strong, unique password phrases for each of your accounts, updated regularly, offer ample protection against hackers. Multi-factor authentication (MFA) adds yet another layer of security by double-checking your identity beyond your username and password, usually with a texted or emailed code.
