What Should I Do if I Receive a Suspicious Email?

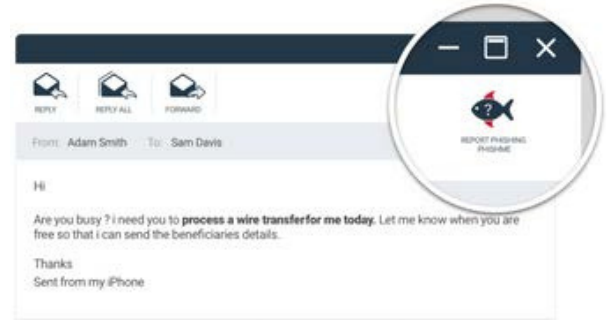
If you suspect you have received or reacted to a spear phishing email, report it immediately by selecting the email and then clicking on the **Report Phishing Cofense button** located in your Outlook toolbar.

Taking this simple action will notify the Global Information Security team (GIS) about the possible attack. If the email is a simulated phishing exercise that is part of our awareness program, you will receive instant feedback thanking you for reporting.

If the email is malicious, quick reporting will help us investigate. Your active participation is crucial to help protect our organization, **remember you are the first line of defense.**

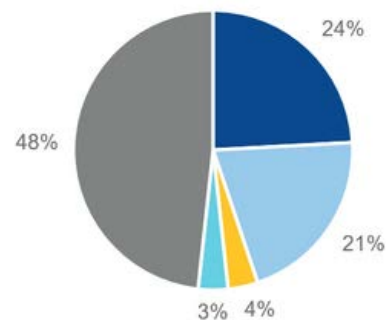
