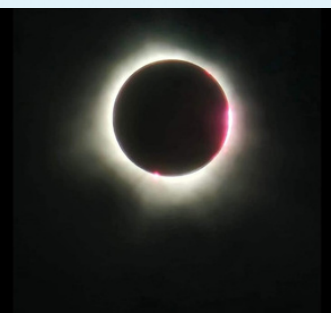

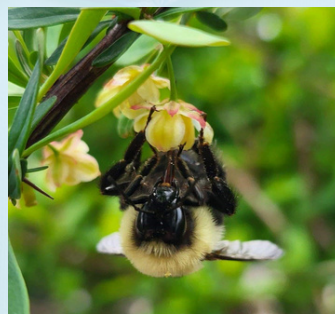

Safety Spotlight: Slips, Trips & Falls



Slips, trips and falls are one of the most common types of injuries in the workplace. 240,000 slip, trip and fall injuries are reported each year, and another 30-40,000 are never reported. Rushing, carrying large items, walking through cluttered areas or across wet or uneven surfaces results in nearly 100 injuries within Brink's U.S. each year.

Protect yourself! Carry objects which you can see over, and can safely control. Also, avoid rushing, running, hurrying or jumping. Hurrying makes you less attentive of things around you and makes you less likely to respond quickly and decisively to avoid injury. Remember to put things away when you're done with them and on shelves or off the floor. Clean up spills or leaks as quickly as possible or mark them with cones until the issue can be corrected.

Pay attention to your surroundings, limit distractions, and watch for hazards. Safety is everyone's responsibility and it starts with YOU!

Cyber Hacks: Are QR Codes Safe to Use?

A QR code is a type of barcode that can be read easily by a digital device and stores information as a series of pixels in a square-shaped grid. Attackers can embed malicious URLs containing custom malware into a QR code which could then exfiltrate data from a mobile device when scanned. It is also possible to insert a malicious URL inside a QR code, redirecting users to a phishing site where they can submit personal or financial information.

How to avoid becoming a victim of QR code fraud:

- Once you scan a QR code, check the web address to make sure it is the intended site and looks authentic. Look for typos or even a single misplaced letter.
- Be cautious about entering login, personal, or financial information into a site navigated to from a QR code.
- If scanning a physical QR code on a sign, window, or placard, ensure it has not been tampered with.
- Do not download a QR code scanner app. This increases your risk of downloading malware onto your device. Most phones have a built-in scanner in the camera.

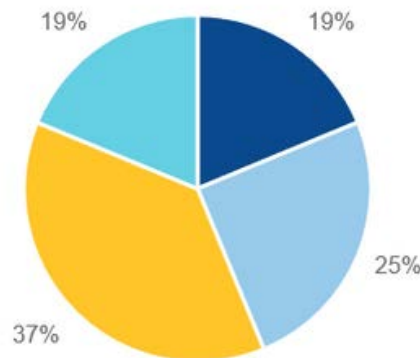
