Juneteenth:

Freedom Day



In 1997, the official **Juneteenth flag** in red, white and blue, was designed to represent the June 19 holiday widely celebrated by Black Americans in the U.S.

Civil rights activist **Ben Haith** created the flag with colors and symbols to represent freedom and the end of slavery. The date of June 19, 1865, represents the order issued in Galveston, Texas, to end slavery in the state of Texas, and other states in the South.

Beginning in 2020, many states began recognizing Juneteenth by flying the flag over their capitol buildings, especially after it was declared a federal holiday by President Joe Biden in 2021.

Juneteenth or June 19, will be **observed as a holiday** at Brink's U.S. office locations.



National Safety Month: Risk Reduction

Safety Hierarchy



At the top of the pyramid is the most effective practice – to physically remove the hazard or design a business process that minimizes hazards and risks. At Brink's, all of the Safety practices in our facilities have been tested and implemented along this standard to eliminate dangerous hazards and conditions, and to keep our teams safe every day.

It is always important to recognize and prioritize the value of workplace safety before an incident happens.

The time for change is now – the 2024 Cloud Migration project is officially underway.

Cloud migration is an exciting IT program to strengthen the functionality and reliability of our business applications, and enable us to better serve our customers.

Our current North American and Chile data center infrastructure has reached its end-of-life and must be replaced to ensure the continued functionality and efficiency of Brink's technology systems. Cloud migration is a critical step in creating a **resilient and scalable infrastructure** to support business growth now and in the future.



Impact: This migration will include 160 critical applications such as iCash, iTrack, Ocean/Dolphin, EBSNA, BGFS, Procesa, DESA, CyberArk, BizTalk and other applications in our North America and Chilean data centers. These applications are in use across United States, Canada, Mexico, Chile, France, and the broader Latin America region, encompassing the Dominican Republic.

Owners of Applications Moving to the Cloud: Application owners will be actively involved in the migration planning process. This collaboration will continue throughout the project, ensuring that migration windows are scheduled, and potential downtime is planned in advance to minimize business impact. All migrations will include thorough testing, rollback procedures, and cooperative decision-making with the business.

The Cloud Migration project represents a significant upgrade in our business technology, and will help us innovate our service offerings faster to exceed customer expectations. While this project may not involve your day-to-day work directly, it does impact our business and our customers, and we want to keep you engaged and informed on this game changer for Brink's.
