Leading the Way with Virtual Reality Training

Brink's is the first organization that provides cash and valuables management, digital retail solutions and ATM managed services to offer virtual reality training for team members.

Virtual reality is a simulated experience that employs 3D near-eye displays to immerse the user in its content.

"Our focus for virtual reality learning is currently on 5S Lean in the field welcoming each learner to the reality training, enabling them to gather basic understanding of the Lean 5S process and what it looks like within their environment," said Kim Watts, U.S. Director Operational Training.

Below are a few highlights since launching and implementing virtual reality - **see how our team is leading the way!**

- 2021: The virtual reality training program launched with a focus to help **reduce errors** and losses with ATMs.
- 2022: Virtual reality lessons for servicing Brink's Complete Safes were launched for CIT Messengers.
- 2023: Courses were deployed through VR goggles for CVS Tellers on Brink's Complete processing.
- 2024: Released the learning lessons for 5S Lean for CIT, CVS, Vault and Coin through VR.

Preventing Credential Theft

Credential theft **steals personal information such as usernames, passwords and financial information** in order to gain access to an online account or system. It is a form of identity theft and can involve the use of malicious software or phishing techniques.

Common Causes of Credential Theft

- Malicious programs like malware can infect users' devices and steal credentials.
- Phishing attacks often abuse trust in popular brands to trick victims into giving up their credentials.
- Attackers take advantage of poor password security practices to gain access to systems, applications and data.

What You Can Do To Prevent Credential Theft

- **Enable Multifactor Authentication (MFA)** which requires a user to present two or more pieces of evidence to verify and authenticate their identity before they are granted the access they are requesting.
- **Complete Brink's Security Awareness Training.** By completing training, you will be able recognize phishing attacks and social engineering schemes.
- **Create a strong passphrase/password** that is more difficult for attackers to crack. These passwords should be rotated regularly and should not be shared between co-workers. Additionally, you should avoid reusing the same password across multiple sites or services.
