

Breast Cancer Awareness: The Importance of Mammograms

Mammograms are important for breast cancer awareness and prevention because **they can detect breast cancer early, when it's most treatable.**

Early detection

Mammograms can detect breast cancer before symptoms develop, including tumors that are too small to feel.

Saves lives

Mammograms have helped reduce breast cancer mortality in the U.S. by nearly 40% since 1990.

High survival rate

When detected early, the 5-year relative survival rate for breast cancer is 99%.

The American Cancer Society recommends that women get **yearly mammograms** from age 40 to age 75. Women should ask their healthcare provider when a mammogram is right for them.

Be sure to get your free annual physical and download the Sydney Health app by Dec. 31, to avoid a surcharge in 2025!
