Cyber Hacks: The Importance of Social Media Security

Social media security takes center stage because social networks are the most crucial elements of any organization's online presence.

The rising social media security risks have made organizations cautious against these social networking platforms. Threat actors excessively use them for **phishing attacks**, not to mention social engineering surveillance techniques that make people more vulnerable.



Some ways to protect yourself:

- **Avoid oversharing** Posting personal information provides the information cybercriminals need to create more realistic phishing attacks or commit identity theft.
- **Avoid public Wi-Fi** Using social media via untrusted, public Wi-Fi hotspots is a significant risk because public Wi-Fi is more susceptible to hackers intercepting communications.
- Reject unknown friend requests Cybercriminals can send friend requests from an authentic-looking account that has mutual friends, hoping users will accept to initiate a social engineering attack.
